This project is a remodel of an existing hospital floor to accommodate patients recovering from heart attacks and other heart ailments. Sixteen patient rooms were completely renovated. Each room includes a bathroom with a shower, as well as a sleeping couch and a bit of storage for family.

Of course, the patient beds are completely mobile, but the casework and finishes in each room are designed to be soothing and comforting. The cabinetry in the bed surround, is what you would expect to find in an elegant hotel. And, although it is warmly inviting, it hides a wealth of high tech healthcare equipment that is at the staff's fingertips.

Four nurses' stations are arranged along the hall, each responsible for four patient rooms each. Materials are carried through to the department entry, generously sized waiting room and reception desk, to create a cohesive new home for heart care.
